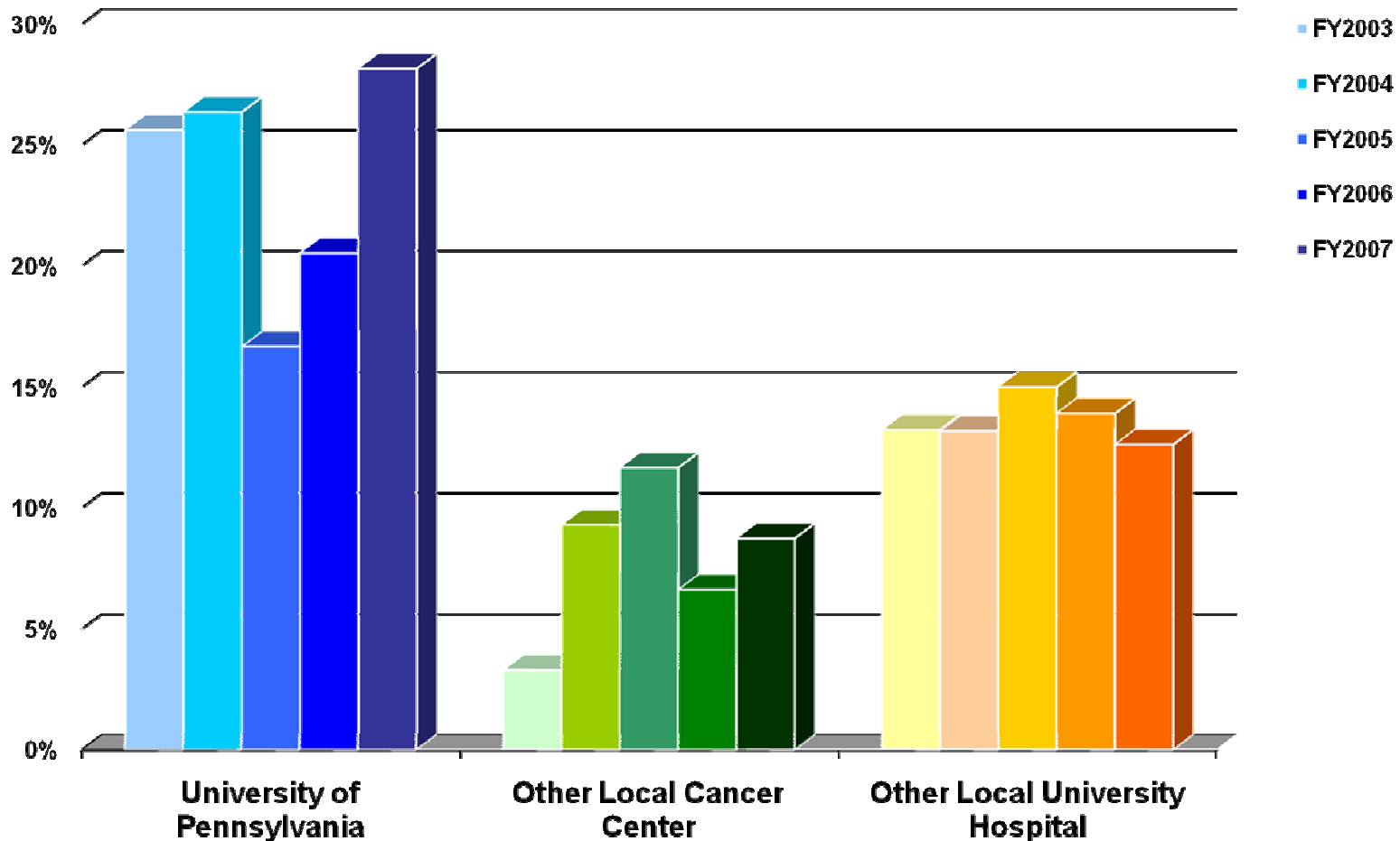


Oropharynx Cancer – Experience Counts
